

Welcome Easter



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Supplies:

- Stamp Sets: Welcome Easter (151559)
- Cardstock: Rococo Rose (150882); Whisper White (100730); Smoky Slate (131202)
- Ink: Memento Black Ink (132708); Smoky Slate (147113)
- Tools & Accessories: Daisy Punch (143713); Stitched So Sweetly Dies (151690); Noble Peacock Rhinestones (149494); Snail Adhesive (104332); Stampin' Dimensionals (104430); Paper Snips (103579); Bone Folder (102300); Stampin' Blends: in Rococo Rose Light (149570), Petal Pink Light (146866), Smoky Slate Light (145054), Crumb Cake Light (144582), Pool Party Light (144595) and Color Lifter (144608)
- Designer Paper: Neutrals 6" x 6" Designer Series Paper Pack

Measurements:

- Card Base: Rococo Rose 8 ½" x 5 ½", score at 4 ¼" on the long side
- Cardstock #2: Smoky Slate 4" x 2 ½"
- Cardstock #3: Whisper White Layer 5 ¼" x 4", and approx. 7" x 6" for bunny, flowers, and sentiment
- Designer Paper: Smoky Slate Gingham Pattern 5" x 3 ¾"

Instructions:

- Adhere Whisper White layer and the Smoky Slate Designer Series Paper to the card front.
- Die cut the 2 shapes for the sentiment using the larger die with Smoky Slate Cardstock and the smaller die with Whisper White Cardstock.
- Stamp the sentiment using Smoky Slate Ink on the white layer. Adhere the Smoky Slate die cut with snail adhesive to the card front and then "pop" the sentiment up using Stampin' Dimensionals.

- Stamp the bunny on Whisper White Cardstock in Memento Black Ink and also punch 3 daisies in Whisper White with the Daisy Punch.
- Color your bunny with Stampin' Blends. I used a combo of Smoky Slate and Crumb Cake around my bunny just for highlights. I still wanted my bunny to be white. I used Rococo Rose and Petal Pink for his features and then I used the color lifter all over to make him look soft and blend all the colors. Lastly, I outlined him with Pool Party then cut him out.
- Curl up your flower petals with a bone folder to make them stand out. Then layer the flowers turning each layer to make it look full. I just used snail adhesive to attach them to one another.
- Then, cut your bunny's head off the body!! Attach the head to the center of the layered flowers with a Stampin' Dimensional.
- Using your Whisper White Scraps cut a piece about 1" x ½". Attach that piece to the back of your bunny body with most of it sticking out at the bunny's neck. Then, add a dimensional to the top of that strip and add it behind the flower. This will let the body show a little more under the flower. Add one dimensional behind the flower and add snail to the bunny body and attach to the card front.
- Finish off with a couple Noble Peacock Rhinestones on the sentiment.
