Supplies:

- Stamp Sets: Hey Birthday Chick (154464) *bundle (158627), All Wired Up (149262)
- Cardstock: Very Vanilla (144237), Cherry Cobbler (119685), Gray Granite (146983), Early Espresso (119686), Basic White Thick (159229), Window Sheets (142314)
- Ink: Jet Black Stazon (101406), Tuxedo Black Memento (132708), Gray Granite (147118)
- Stampin' Blends Combo: Daffodil Delight (154883), Pumpkin Pie (154897), Cherry Cobbler (154880), Crumb Cake (154882), Cajun Craze (154879), Real Red (154899), Smoky Slate (154904)
- Tools & Accessories: Birthday Chick Die (158200) *bundle (158627) Multipurpose Liquide Glue (110755), Layering Circle Dies (151770), Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653), Stampin' Dimensionals (104430),

Measurements:

- Card Base: Cherry Cobbler 11 x 4¼ score at 5½
- Cardstock #2: Gray Granite 5¼ x 4
- Cardstock #3: Very Vanilla Thick 5¼ x 4
- Cardstock #4: Window Sheet 3½ x 3½
- Cardstock #5: Early Espresso 3 x 3
- Cardstock #6: Basic White Thick 4¼ x 2
- Cardstock #7: Cherry Cobbler 4¼ x 2¼

Instructions:

1. Stamp the wire on the window sheet using StazOn ink.
2. Place the Gray Granite on to the front for the Cherry Cobbler card front base and die cut the 2½ circle.

3. Nest the 2½ and the 2¾ circle on top of the Early Espresso and die cut. (this will be the frame of the window)
4. Stamp randomly the little chick with the hat on the Gray Granite layer.
5. Adhere the Early Espresso frame around the opening of the Gray Granite layer.
6. Place *DON'T GLUE the Very Vanilla card stock inside the Cherry Cobbler card base. Close the card, make a mark with a pencil in the center of the opening.
7. Open the card, stamp the Chick with cupcake in the center. Guide yourself with the pencil mark for the center.
8. Remove from the card base. Color with Stamping Blends. I use all the colors listed in the supplies.
9. Adhere the very vanilla piece inside. ONLY after you are done coloring.
10. Adhere the window sheet on top of the Cherry Cobbler card front around the center of the circle window.
11. Adhere the Gray Granite layers on the card front.
12. Stamp the chick with the balloon using Memento ink on to the Basic White thick card stock.
13. Color with blends. Again, I use all of the colors listed in the supplies.
14. Die-cut with the matching die.
15. Die-cut the Happy Birthday and the balloon that is part of the chick out of the Cherry Cobbler strip.
16. Adhere the Cherry Cobbler balloon in the back of the color balloon. (this will show in the window when opening so it will cover the blending that bleed through the white card stock.)
17. Adhere the Chick with balloon using dimensionals and the Happy Birthday using liquid glue.
