

Butterfly Bouquet “Floating Butterflies”



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Supplies:

- Stamp Sets: Good Morning Magnolia (149268)
- Cardstock: Basic White Thick (159229), Window Sheets (142314), Butterfly Bijou (156824)
- Ink: Tuxedo Black Memento (132708), Balmy Blue (147105)
- Tools & Accessories: Blending Brushes (153611), Happy Dies (152708), Tear & Tape Adhesive (138995), Multipurpose Liquide Glue (110755), Brilliant Wings Dies (155523), Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653), Stampin' Dimensionals (104430), Not Stampin'Up! A fine point black sharpie

Measurements:

- Card Base: Basic White thick 6¾ x 4¼ score at 5½
- Cardstock #2: Window Sheet 5-3/8 x 4¼
- Cardstock #3: Butterfly Bijou 2 sheet of the big butterflies, and 2 of 4¼ x 1
- Cardstock #4: Basic White thick 5½ x 3

Instructions:

1. Die cut both of the big butterfly sheets with the big die (6 die all in one).
2. Adhere the window sheet to the card base using Tear & Tape. Place two strip of the tear and tape inside the top portion of the card base. Align the window sheet on the card base and close the top portion.
3. On the small portion of the card base, adhere a strips of designer paper to the front and one inside.
4. Front of the window sheet adhere 3 butterflies with dimensionals. *The mint butterfly cut in half.
5. Inside the window sheet adhere the matching butterfly with glue dots. (the mint butterfly use the other half of the one that was cut in half.
6. Front of the window sheet, draw the “flight pattern” using a fin tip sharpie.
7. Using the 5½ x 3 basic white die cut the cloud strip from the Happy die.

8. Using a blending brush with Balmly Blue ink, brush the cloud inside the card. Use the cloud strip for the mask when brushing the ink, starting from top to bottom.
9. At the bottom right stamp the Hello using Black Memento ink.
10. To the back of the card adhere another butterfly. *the back would be the best place to write your memo.
